Call for Papers: IPMA Research Conference 2027

The 15th IPMA Research Conference is now accepting paper submissions. Researchers, academics, practitioners, doctoral candidates, project management experts, and policymakers from around the world are invited to contribute to one of the leading international forums dedicated to advancing project management research and strengthening its connection with practice.

Hosted in the historic Hofburg Palace in Vienna from 19–21 May 2027, the conference will explore the theme "Impact from Research to Practical Project Management and Vice Versa." It highlights the dynamic relationship between research and practice—how scientific insights inspire innovative projects, while practical experience generates new research questions and drives future developments.

Authors are invited to submit original contributions across a broad range of topics, including:

- Engaging practice and scholarship for greater impact
- Managing and financing research collaboration
- Disruptive education and learning
- Sustainable, responsible project, programme, and portfolio management
- Project leadership, careers, and professional development
- Artificial intelligence and innovation in projects
- The evolving project society

The conference offers an exceptional opportunity to present research, receive valuable feedback from peers, engage with leading journal editors during the Meet the Editors Session, exchange ideas with researchers and practitioners from around the world, and establish new collaborations for future research projects. Outstanding papers will be recognized through the Best Conference Paper Award, while selected authors will be invited to submit extended versions of their work to leading international journals.

Submissions are welcome in two categories:

- **Full Papers** (3,500–6,000 words), published in the Conference Proceedings and submitted for indexation in Web of Science and Scopus.
- **Early-Stage Research**, providing a platform for emerging research ideas and applied studies.

- **Notification of acceptance:** February 15, 2027
- **Early Bird registration for authors:** February 28, 2027
- **15th IPMA Research Conference:** May 19–21, 2027
